See if you can complete this challenge using any other number less than 100 as Rudolph's favourite number.

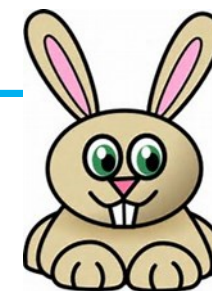
